A Message from Jason *Course Superintendent*

A quick update on the course coming into spring:

- * We've transplanted over 100 trees to holes 1, 9, 10, 11, & 17
- * 18 dead standing Ash trees have been removed from the 11th, 17th, and 18th holes
- * Sprinklers are installed on holes 2, 8, 11, & 17 as part of the 2nd year of a 3 year irrigation automation plan. During the season, sprinklers will be added to the final fairways to complete the project
- * The greens have been deep tined-aerified, sprayed for winter, and top dressed in preparation for this upcoming season
- * The Red tee deck on the 1st hole has been enlarged, so the Gold tees have an improved elevated tee box
- * The 3rd hole also has an improved, elevated tee box that now includes the blue, white, and gold tees
- * New/repared foot bridges on the 18th hole, between holes 8-9, and between holes 2-3
- * Finally, we are getting 2 new rough cutting machines. This will help improve course conditions, pace of play, and help add stripes to the fairways
